Objectives

The main objectives of the Council are:

1. To advance and promote the cause of education and research in chemical science.
2. To publish research journals, proceedings, transactions and other materials of standard quality and topical interest.
3. To organize symposia, discussions, special lectures, exhibitions and such other activities necessary for a better understanding of chemical research and its applications for the economic, social and industrial programmes.
4. To strive for strengthening national co-operations and contacts amongst scientists of the country.
5. To associate with National and International scientists working in the fields of Chemistry and to co-operate with other organizations having similar objectives.

Submission of Abstracts

Active participation in scientific sessions covering the topics of the Conference is welcome. Scientists/Researchers are requested to submit only soft copy of abstract (not more than 200 words) of the papers intended for presentation to the CONCERNED SECTIONAL PRESIDENT and CC, Secretary latest by October 31, 2024 on their E-mail addresses. The abstract should be submitted online as an e-mail attachment. It should be typed in MS-word using Times New Roman with font size 12. Authors should clearly mention on the top of the abstract, the section in which the paper is to be considered. They should mention their telephone no., fax no. and e-mail address along with their postal address. No hard copy is required.

Note: All authors contributing a paper in the Conference must be Fellows of the Council. (Annual fellowship fee Rs 600/- for the year 2024 or life fellowship fee Rs. 6000/- must be paid along with the submission of the abstract.)

Registration

All participants are required to register in advance by sending a registration fee of Rs. 2500 (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) by November 30, 2024.

The registration fee should be paid by a crossed demand draft made in favor of the 'Indian Council of Chemists' payable at Agra or by online mode as indicated in the registration form. Registration fee for accompanying person (spouse & children) is Rs. 1250/- (Rupees One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty only) without kit. The registration form & demand draft should be sent to : Dr. M. K. 1. **Life Time Achievement Award**, carrying a citation and Gold Medal to be given annually to a senior eminent scientist preferably above the age of 60 years, who has made distinguished contribution to any field of Chemical Sciences.
2. **Prof. Wahid Uddin Malik Memorial Award**, carrying a citation and cash award of Rs. 15,000, given annually to an eminent Chemical Scientist on the basis of his / her significant contribution in any field of Chemistry. The award has been instituted by **Mr. Mujeeb Malik**, son of **Prof. W.U. Malik**.
3. **Prof. S. P. Hiremath Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 15,000/- given annually to an eminent scientist actively engaged in any branch of Chemistry at National level on the basis of his/her significant contribution. The award has been instituted by **Dr. (Mrs.) Ujwala S. Hiremath**, wife of **Prof. S. P. Hiremath**.
4. **Dr. Arvind Kumar Memorial Award**, carrying a citation and cash award of Rs. 10,000/-, given annually to an Indian Scientist, up to the age of 45 years, actively engaged in any area of Chemical Sciences at national level. The award has been instituted by **Mrs. Bharati Arvind**, wife of **Dr. Arvind Kumar**.
5. **Prof. Kaza Somasekhara Rao Award**, instituted in the memory of his wife **Smt. Kaza Indiradevi**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 10000/- only for best Women Scientist in Chemistry.

8. **Prof. P.N. Sharma Memorial Award**, carrying a citation and cash award of Rs. 15,000/- given annually to a **best teacher** actively engage in any branch of chemistry at national level. The award has been instituted by his family members.
9. **Prof. G. Gopala Rao Centenary Commemorative Award**, carrying a citation and a cash award of Rs. 1000/- given annually to one young researcher whose paper, presented in the Analytical Chemistry / Physical Chemistry section by rotation.

Selection Procedure for Awards 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 above

1. Head of the respective Department / Institute / ICC Life Member could nominate a person for the award.
2. Each such nomination should be accompanied with; a) CV of the person so nominated for the award to be received by the Secretary, ICC latest by 15th November of the year of the award.
b) Reprints of 5 best publications preferably during the past 5 years
3. Last Date of such nomination / application would be November 15, 2024. The complete application with all documents should be sent to **Prof. Rajesh Dhakarey**, Secretary, ICC, Department of Chemistry, Institute of Basic Sciences, Khandari, Agra-282002.
4. Selected candidate shall give a presentation of 30 minutes duration in the ICC conference at which the award will be conferred.
5. The selection for these awards will be made by a panel of eminent chemists in a fair and transparent manner.

Young Scientist Award

The Council gives an award and a certificate to young scientists up to the age of 35 years for the best paper presented in oral and poster sessions separately in all the sections. Those interested in participating in the contest must write in bold letters "CYSA" on the right corner at the top of the abstract and enclose the proof of the age, i.e. photocopy of High School Certificate. The awards will be given in the valedictory function of the Conference.

Memorial Lectures

1. **Prof. T.N. Srivastava Memorial Lecture** : Prof. TN. Srivastava (Lucknow) an eminent inorganic chemist was the sectional president of Inorganic Chemistry Section in the first Conference of the Council held at Agra when Council was founded in 1981.
